Do not post nor share your answers with anyone whether you submit the test or not, by doing this you are violating the copyright and will be prosecuted. There is no penalty for incorrect answers. One submission is allowed. Send your answers to [info@iqlati.net](mailto:info@iqlati.net), you will normally receive your score report within one week.
